- B. The Shehnai of Bismillah Khan

- Why did Aurangzeb ban the playing of the pungi? 1.
- The pungi had an unpleasant shrill sound. Due to its irritating quality, Aurangzeb banned the A. playing of pungi.
- 2. How is a shehnai different from a pungi?
- Shehnai is the refined version of pungi. A barber, who was a regular visitor to the king's A. palace, used a naturally hollow stems to put pungi's reed into and made shehnai. Shehnai had pleasant sound unlike pungi. As it was played by a barber (nai in Hindi) before the king (shah in Urdu) so it was given the name Shehnai.
- 3. Where was the shehnai played traditionally? How did Bismillah Khan change this?
- Traditionally the Shehnai was played in temples and during wedding ceremonies, as it A. was considered an auspicious instrument. Bismillah Khan brought Shehnai into mainstream music and changed the way people perceived Shehnai.
